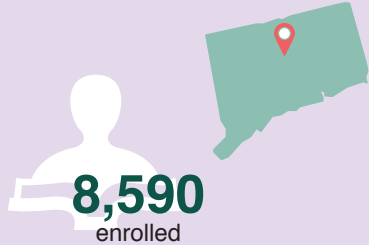
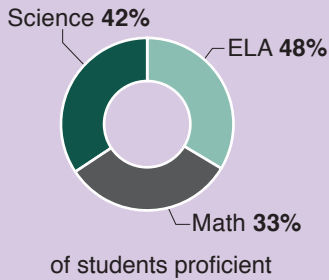
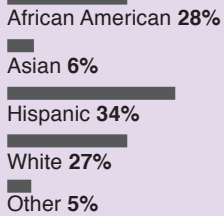

Project Overview

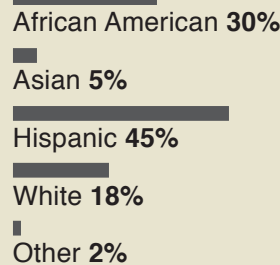
Capitol Region Education Council, in consortium with Enfield Public Schools, is converting a PreK school from a traditional program to a science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics (STEAM) magnet program, and is significantly revising three whole-school secondary magnet programs with science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM); public service and leadership; and global citizenship and changemaking themes. Using an interdistrict model, the Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded schools create equitable, diverse learning environments by attracting students from different racial/ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds and fostering meaningful interactions among students.

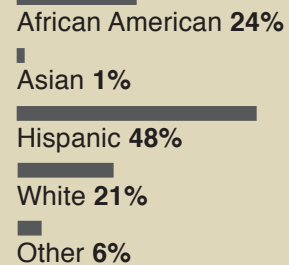

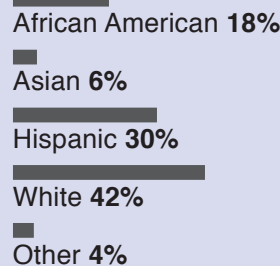

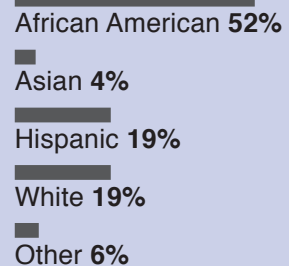
