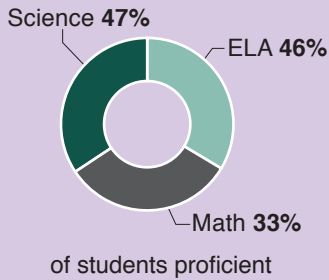
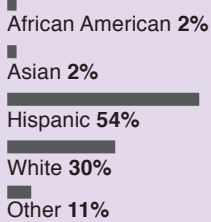


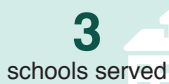

Project Overview

Napa Valley Unified School District is significantly expanding an arts magnet program at an elementary school; significantly revising an International Baccalaureate magnet elementary school to introduce a communication and media program; and converting an elementary school from a traditional program to a leadership, engineering, and art design magnet school. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project inspires academic excellence and provides an enriching environment to develop student interests in related theme-based fields for college and career readiness. In addition, the MSAP schools are increasing racial and socioeconomic integration to provide disadvantaged students the opportunity to attend higher performing and less socioeconomically isolated schools.

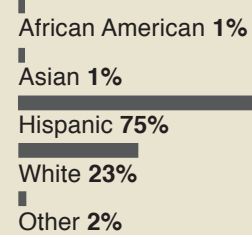

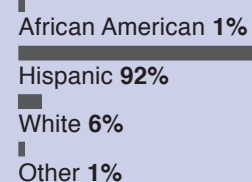

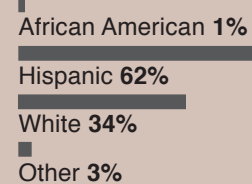
