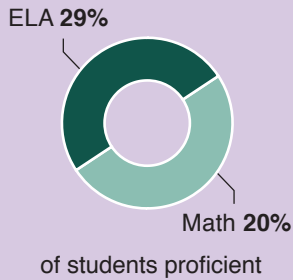
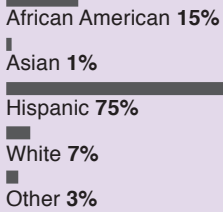

Project Overview

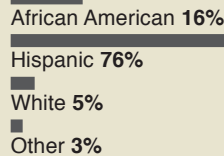
Palmdale School District is creating a new magnet middle school and converting four middle schools from traditional programs to magnet programs. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project is expanding school choice to reduce, eliminate, or prevent racial and socioeconomic isolation and to improve the academic achievement of all students. The MSAP schools are designed to create and sustain systemic change in educational practices and school culture. Each school will have a science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics focus that links to the local aerospace, business, and professional communities.

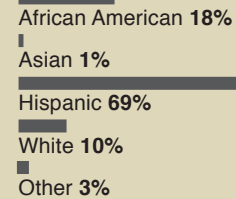

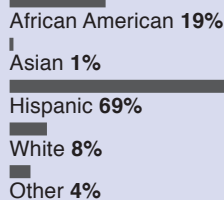

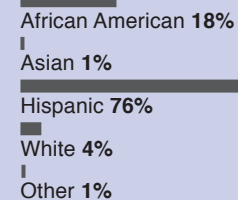

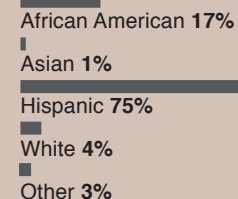
