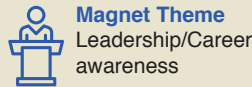


## Project Overview

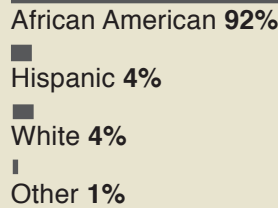

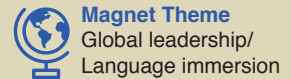

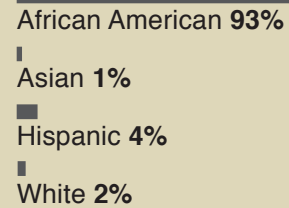

#### Carver-Lyon Elementary School

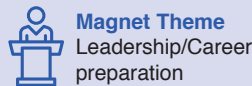

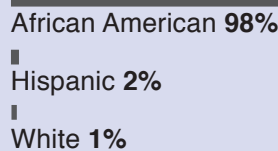

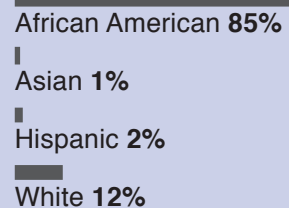
