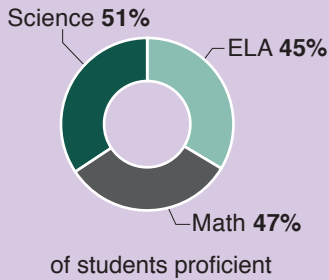
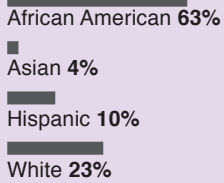

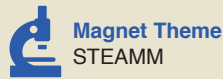
Project Overview

Richland School District Two is converting an elementary school and a middle school from traditional programs to magnet programs and is revising an elementary school and a high school to science, technology, arts, mathematics, and medical (STEAMM) programs. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project provides a clearly articulated, challenging K-12 curriculum that offers meaningful opportunities for student and community engagement and that meets the demands of Columbia, South Carolina's growing healthcare industry. In addition, partnerships with higher education and community and professional organizations build program sustainability.

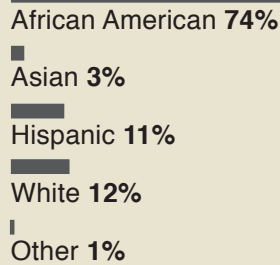

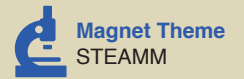

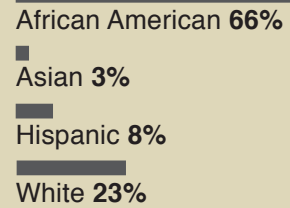
Grades 6-8

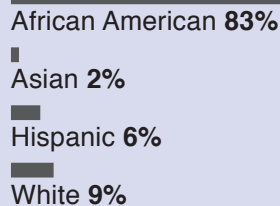

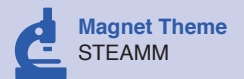

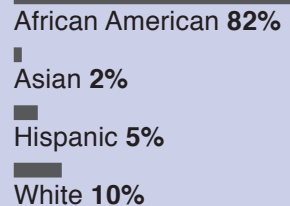
