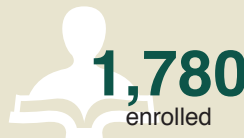


Project Overview

School Board of Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade County Public Schools, is converting one elementary school from a traditional program to a whole-school magnet program and establishing a new partial magnet high school and a whole-school high school magnet program; both high schools have three theme-based academies. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project will increase student access to postsecondary and career opportunities in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). The project is reducing minority group and socioeconomic isolation; increasing academic achievement of all students in reading, math, and science; implementing innovative STEM curricula; and increasing local, regional, and national partnerships to provide access to real-world STEM experiences. In addition, professional development builds the capacity of core subject and magnet theme teachers to deliver innovative curricula to students.

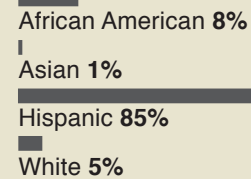

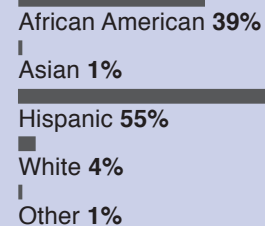

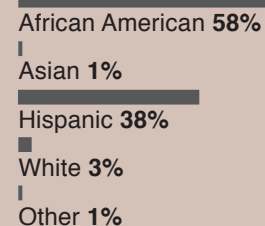
