## Project Overview

Seminole County Public Schools is converting three elementary schools from traditional programs to magnet programs. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project is implementing effective educational practices and strategies to help students meet high academic standards and master rigorous curricula. The schools use a transdisciplinary approach combined with inquiry-based learning strategies to develop global competencies and to engage all students in the learning process. In addition, the MSAP schools advance the district's vision of ensuring that all students have equitable opportunities that prepare them to be lifelong learners and productive citizens. The project is reducing minority group and socioeconomic isolation at the schools, with the ultimate outcome of improving student learning and academic achievement while closing the achievement gap.

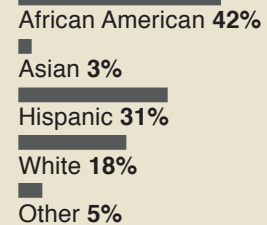

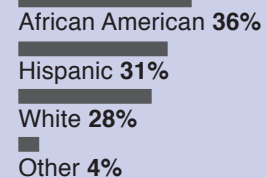

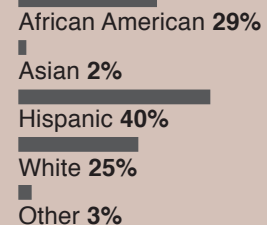
