## Project Overview

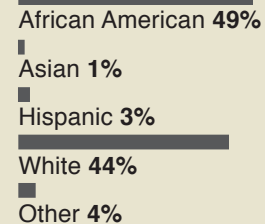
Texarkana Arkansas School District is revising two middle school magnet programs and converting a high school from a traditional program to a magnet program. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project builds on the district's successful science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) magnet elementary school to create a K-12 STEM pathway. The MSAP schools embrace personalized learning, project-based learning, and STEM curricula to enhance meaningful learning for all students. In addition, pre-advanced placement (AP) and advanced coursework is offered in grades 5-8 to prepare students for AP courses in high school. The rigorous academic experiences in hands-on, high-tech environments facilitate learning and encourage the development of intellectual and social skills for all students.

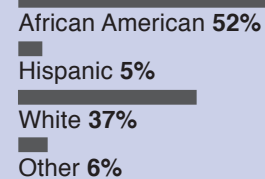

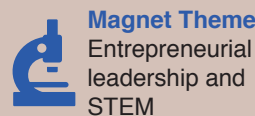

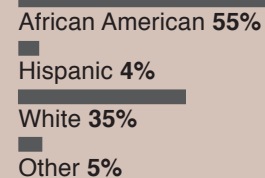
