Project Overview

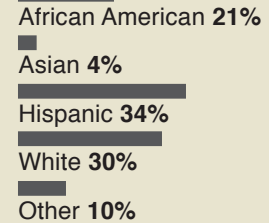
Clark County School District is converting two middle schools and one elementary school from traditional programs to whole-school science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) magnet programs. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project uses STEM education, blended learning, personalized learning, and project-based learning to form an instructional foundation to improve academic achievement for all students. The MSAP schools' STEM themes offer opportunities for greater student engagement, improved school climate, and improved academic achievement in the core subjects. In addition, the theme-based curriculum is linked to opportunities from local industries, community business, and higher education. While each school's STEM theme will have a unique focus, each magnet program enables students to apply STEM knowledge and concepts within various contexts.

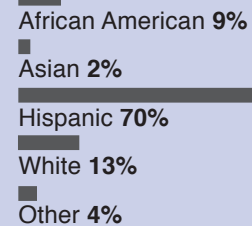

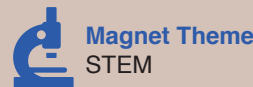

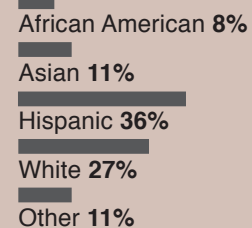
