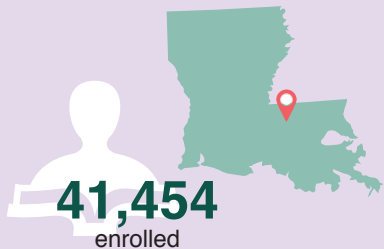
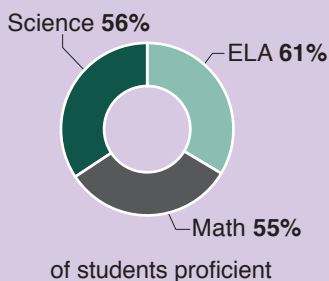
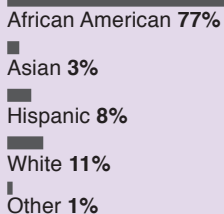

Project Overview

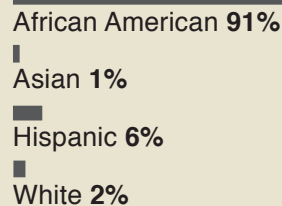
East Baton Rouge Parish School System is establishing partial magnet programs with creative science and arts themes in two traditional elementary schools, a traditional middle school, and a traditional high school. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project incorporates science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics (STEAM) and racial and economic diversity within each school. Systemic professional development opportunities help teachers build their students STEAM literacy. In addition, student-centered learning environments help students build academic connections and develop critical thinking skills to prepare them for jobs and learning in the future.

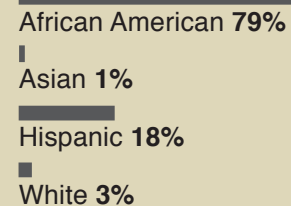

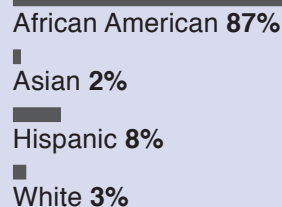

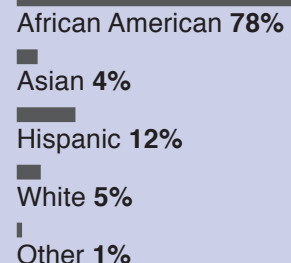
