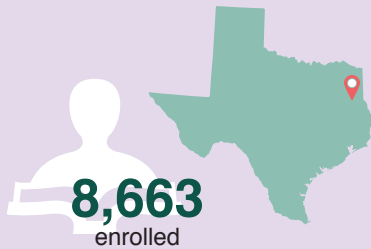


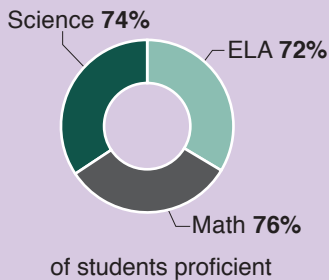
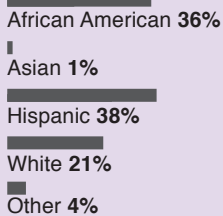

## Project Overview

Longview Independent School District is developing two new elementary magnet schools and is transforming an elementary school, a middle school, and a high school from traditional programs to magnet programs. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP) schools create critical, independent thinkers that succeed academically and become productive members of society. The project is expanding Montessori and International Baccalaureate programming and infuses science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics (STEAM) to build students' skills so they are able to meet the workforce needs of local, regional, and global markets. The MSAP schools are reducing minority group isolation and increasing socioeconomic integration by promoting systemic reform, developing innovative educational practices that promote diversity, and providing equitable access to high-quality educational programs.

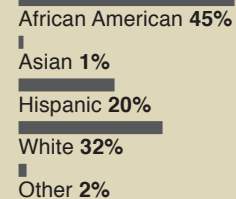

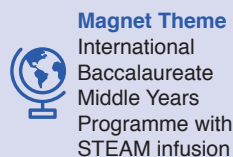

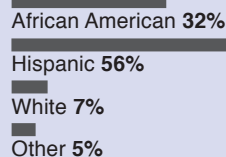

### Forest Park Middle School

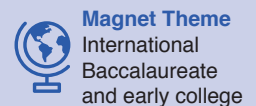

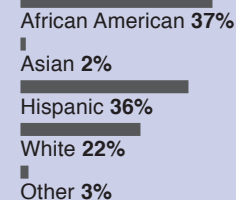

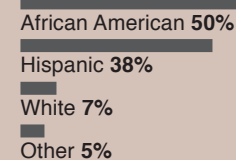
