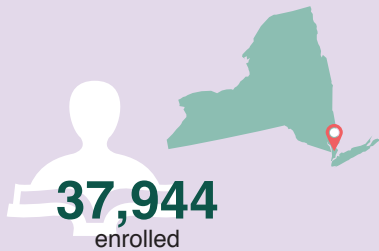
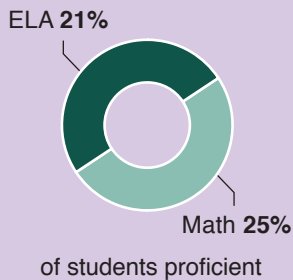
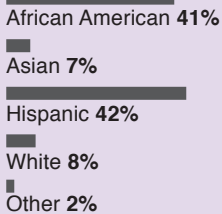

Project Overview

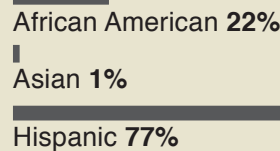

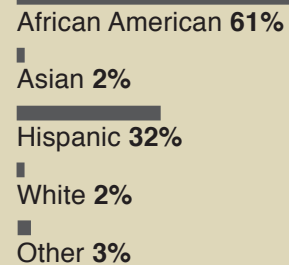

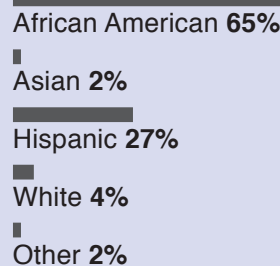

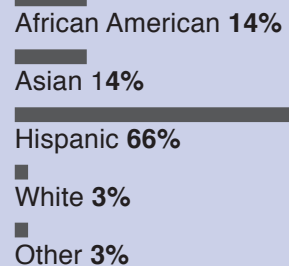
