Project Overview

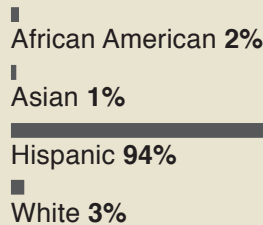
New York City (NYC) Community School District 6 is converting four elementary schools into whole-school magnet programs. These four new school choice options provide rigorous educational experiences that promote student achievement and college and career readiness. Each school promotes the development, implementation, and refinement of interdisciplinary thematic curricula mapped to city, state, and national standards along with rich parent engagement activities aligned to the themes. In addition, these Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded schools are creating diverse learning environments by attracting students from different racial and socioeconomic backgrounds.

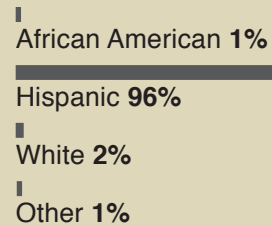

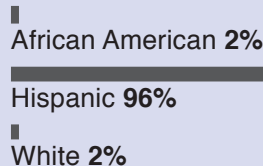

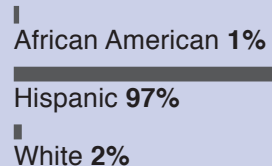
