Project Overview

Independent School District 196 is converting two traditional elementary schools into whole-school magnet programs to inspire and recognize young inventors, researchers, designers, and makers in all students. These Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded programs engage students in rigorous STEM experiences through collaborative, hands-on, and interdisciplinary learning environments (e.g., field experiences with STEM professionals, outdoor learning investigations) to increase 21st century skills and improve student achievement. Teams of educators work together to integrate the magnet theme across subjects and to create parent and community partnerships. The schools are also improving instruction by implementing a Multi-Tiered System of Supports model to guide student interventions. Both schools adopted The Leader in Me best practices and will explore leadership skills across cultures to increase appreciation of diversity. The MSAP schools enroll students from different racial/ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds to create diverse learning environments that promote cooperative learning and leadership skills to prepare students for success in STEM-related careers.

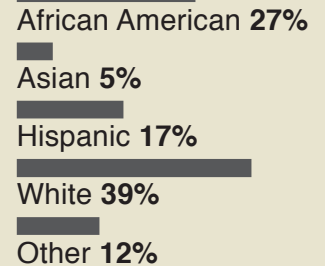

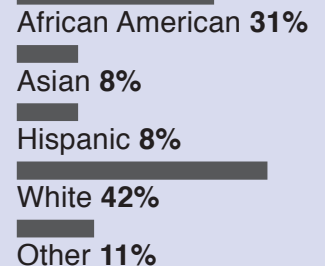
