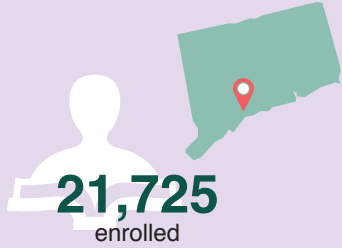
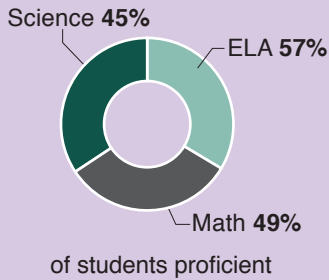
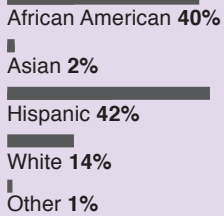

Project Overview

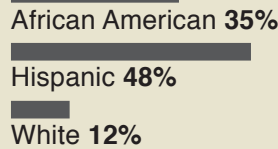
New Haven Public Schools is significantly revising two existing magnet schools and converting two traditional schools into whole-school magnet programs. This interdistrict magnet project attracts students from area urban and suburban school districts to create diverse learning environments—a strategy used to promote problem-solving skills and critical thinking. These Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded schools increase students' access to rigorous, engaging coursework and experienced community partners. Together, these research-based approaches provide students with authentic interdisciplinary STEM learning activities that improve student achievement.

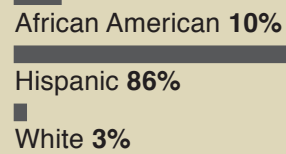

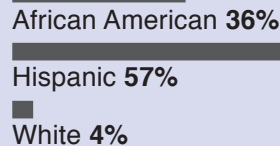

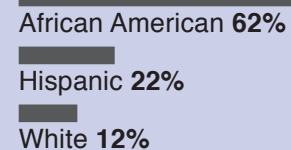
